# **BACKGROUND**

- Australian Institute of Professionals Pty Ltd trades as Australian Institute of Professionals and was acquired by the current ownership in July 2013. The organisation was formerly known as Tradies and Subbies Safety Services Pty Ltd and was initially registered as an RTO on 17 May 2012.
- The organisation is owned by the current CEO's wife, with the CEO having overall responsibility for the management of all business activities. The CEO is supported by a part time marketing and business development manager, and by a part time operations manager. The owner of the organisation assists on a part time basis with human resources related issues.

- The organisation is currently registered to deliver one qualification in bookkeeping and one unit of competency in Occupational Health and Safety Construction Induction. On Monday 4 August 2014 the organisation applied to remove three qualifications and one unit of competency from their scope of registration in the areas of management, accounting and operating a forklift truck.
- The organisation maintains memberships and subscriptions to VELG Training, the Building Industry Commission Victoria, and Consumer affairs New South Wales. There are no agreements or partnerships in place for the outsourcing of training and assessment services.
- The organisation has not yet commenced delivery of training and therefore does not meet the criteria for the conduct of a post initial audit, however on Monday 18 November 2013 the organisation's Academic Director, Tauseef Muhammad, provided delivery data to ASQA stating that five students were currently enrolled within the BSB41412 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety qualification, and that two students had the completed the BSB41407 Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety qualification in the previous 12 months.


